I also recognise that failing to give further notices in writing to the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of becoming aware of any change in order to bring up to date information given in this notice, or in order to declare an interest, which has to be declared, and which are acquired after the date of this notice is also a breach of the Local Code of Conduct.
